Grant County 4-H Family Project Day provides school aged youth (5-Kindergarten and older) with an opportunity to make items as they explore 4-H projects. Come to the Youth and Agriculture Center at the Grant County Fairgrounds on Saturday, February 8, 2025 to join in on the fun! You do NOT need to be in 4-H to attend. Registration will be limited to 185 entries or by January 31; which ever happens first. Projects fill up quickly.


## Youth & Ag Center-Grant County Fairgrounds-Lancaster

If bad weather, check WGLR 97.7 radio station for updates

\*\*Open to ALL in grades 5-Kindergarten and older. Participants do NOT need to be in 4-H\*\*

1. **BEADED KEYCHAIN** (HAZEL GREEN CLEVER CLOVERS 4-H CLUB) You will use beads and string while following a pattern to make an animal keychain. Multiple animal options will be available. (*limit 25 per session*)







3. **CUPCAKE DECORATING** (PLUM VALLEY BOOSTERS 4-H CLUB) Practice decorating cupcakes using various frosting tips and techniques to create designs such as stars, flowers, and other piped designs. Each participant will take home a pack of their decorated cupcakes (*limit 10 per session*)



4. **DECORATED GLASS LANTERN** (TOWN & COUNTRY KIDS 4-H CLUB) Each youth will be given a glass jar with their choice of pressed flowers or tissue paper. They will take mod podge and paint the jar and add the decorations they chose to the jar. Add roping to the top if they like then add a tea light. (*limit 12 per session*)



**DREAM CATCHER** (BLAKE'S PRAIRIE BOMBERS 4-H CLUB) Dream catcher made with a center cut out of a paper plate with a yarn center and yarn tassels. You will also be able to add beads and feathers for decorations and add some color to the paper plate. (*limit 15 per session*)



- 6. MINI BARN QUILT (BLOCKHOUSE BUILDERS 4-H CLUB) FULL
- 7. **POPSICLE STICK CATAPULT** (MERRY MIXERS 4-H CLUB) Build a catapult using popsicle sticks, rubber bands and a spoon and then test out how far you can launch items with it. (limit 16 per session)



**8. SOCK BUNNIES** (STITZER GO-GETTERS 4-H CLUB) No-sew sock bunnies for Spring! Select from a variety of color options for your bunny and decorate it with ribbon or bows. (*limit 10 per session*)



9. STRING ART (ACTIVE AMERICANS 4-H CLUB) Weave yarn around nails to create artwork that you can give as a gift or display in your home! Choose a Christmas, Easter, Valentine's or Halloween design and create your own art! \*\*Kids will be using small hammers to drive in small nails under supervision in small groups. (limit 6 per session)



**10. WIND-UP CARS** (DAIRYLAND DIAMONDS 4-H CLUB) Do you have plastic bottles laying around? Take that trash and create a wind-up car. See how far your "new car" can travel. Plastic bottles will be provided. (*limit 10 per session*)



**11. YARN BUTTERFLY** (BUSY BADGERS 4-H CLUB) Create a butterfly using craft sticks, yarn, pipe cleaners and beads. (limit 6 per session)
