The following guidelines should be followed in regard to 4-H Member Project Records for the Grant County 4-H Program.

4-H MEMBER PROJECT RECORD SHEET

All 4-H members are required to complete one (1) copy of the Grant County 4-H Member Record Sheet or specified record sheet for each project they carry.

4-H PROJECT FINANCIAL RECORD INFORMATION

4-H members grade 6 and under are <u>not required</u> to fill out a 4-H Project Financial Record for any project. 4-H members grade 7 and over, as of January 1 of the year enrolling, must complete a 4-H Project Financial Record as follows:
