# Grant County 4-H Program

## What is 4-H?

The 4-H Youth Development program is the nation's largest youth development and empowerment organization. 4-H cultivates confident youth who tackle the issues that matter most in their communities right now. In the United States, 4-H programs empower six million young people through the 109 land-grant universities and Cooperative Extension in more than 3,000 local offices serving every county and parish in the country. Outside the United States, independent, country-led 4-H organizations empower one million young people in more than 50 countries.

## How does 4-H work?

4-H empowers youth by giving them direct experience with democratic practices and electoral processes as club officers. Youth leaders learn to be accountable for their own leadership and are able to see the immediate effects of their club's decisions.

## Life Skills

4-H teaches important life skills and attitudes like teamwork, problem-solving, responsibility, and positive communication, to name a few. Youth are learning valuable social skills that are desired by employers as they work with certified 4-H adult volunteers to complete 4-H projects.

## Who can join 4-H?

Youth in grades 5k-13 are eligible to join 4-H. Members in 5k through second grade should enroll in Cloverbuds, which is a project that provides them with age appropriate opportunities.
