Come to the Youth and Agriculture Center at the Grant County Fairgrounds on Saturday, February 10, 2024 to join in on the fun! You do NOT need to be in 4-H to attend. \*\*Open to ALL in grades 5-Kindergarten and older. Participants do NOT need to be in 4-H\*\*

**1. BEADED KEYCHAIN ANIMALS** (HAZEL GREEN CLEVER CLOVERS 4-H CLUB) Using beads, create a keychain animal to decorate your bookbag, coat or luggage. (*limit 20 per session*)



2. **BUILD A BIRDHOUSE** (WINGS OVER WI) All supplies will be provided to assemble your very own wooden birdhouse. Youth can take home the assembled birdhouse and customize even more. (*limit 25 per session*)



**BEAD WIND CHIMES** (BLAKE'S PRAIRIE BOMBERS 4-H CLUB) A wind chime made by stringing beads onto thread and attached to a wooden dowel to hang in the wind. (*limit 15 per session*)



4. FAUX STAINED GLASS (TOWN & COUNTRY KIDS 4-H CLUB) Using an 8x10 frame with real glass. Draw or trace a picture in black on the glass. Color the picture in with colored Sharpies. Crinkle up aluminum foil and then spread out flat. Put picture frame and foil all back together. (*limit 12 per session*)



**5. GNOME** (BUSY BADGERS 4-H CLUB) Crafting a Gnome out of yarn and batting material. (*limit 6 per session. For youth in 2<sup>nd</sup> grade or older*)



6. **DECORATIVE WOODEN MAGNETS** (MERRY MIXERS 4-H CLUB) You will be able to make 2 decorative wooden magnets. A variety of vinyl stencils will be available to apply to a pre-cut wooden base. The design is then painted over the stencil. Magnet size is about 3-inch square. (*limit 15 per session*)



7. **LIGHT-UP BIRTHDAY CARD** (DAIRYLAND DIAMONDS 4-H CLUB) Everyone has birthdays, so why not make someone's extra special by creating a birthday card that lights up! (*limit 12 per session*)



**MINI BARN QUILT** (BLOCKHOUSE BUILDERS 4-H CLUB) Choose one pattern out of four options to paint a 1' x 1' mini barn quilt. (*limit 8 per session*)



9. WASHER WIND CHIMES (ACTIVE AMERICANS 4-H CLUB) Attach a variety of metal washers to a wooden dowel to create a wind chime. The perfect project to brighten your Spring garden! (limit 10 per session)



**10. WOOD SNOWMAN** (PLATTEVILLE WOODCHUCKS 4-H CLUB) (This project will take two sessions - 1 hour) - For youth in 6<sup>th</sup> grade or older. Assemble a snowman from pre-cut logs and dowel rods. After assembled, can decorate with paint and holiday ribbon. (*limit 10 per session*)
