4-H Dog Project

The first practice was scheduled for June 3. **Members are required to attend 5 practices to be able to participate at the fair.** If you were not able to attend the first meeting, contact Kaci Busch for the upcoming practices and information that was covered. Practices will be every Tuesday until after the 4th of July and then we will have practice every Tuesday and Thursday. Please join the Google Classroom code 5gqskldp to stay up to date.

Please bring a copy of your vaccination records with you or send them to me in an email by the first meeting you attend. kacibusch@gmail.com All dogs must be vaccinated for distemper and rabies and have proof of vaccination to be able to participate at the fair. Kennel cough isn't required but it is strongly encouraged.

Every practice you will need:

- 1. Dog treats. Something your dog would do ANYTHING for! Popular items are commercial dog treats, hot dogs and cheese.
- 2. Leash. All dogs must always be in control and on leash. Not every dog is dog friendly. We try our best to maintain a safe distance between dogs to prevent any problems.
- 3. Kennel. It is nice to be able to leave your dog and help with set up, clean up or to be dog free when watching others run agility.
- 4. Water, don't forget water for yourself and your dog.
- 5. Treat pouch. Basically, this is a fanny pack you keep your treats in so you aren't digging in your pockets.
- 6. Tennis shoes or boots. The dairy show ring has a sawdust base and sandals don't work very well.

Shooting Sports Practice:

The Grant County 4-H Shooting Sports practices from January - June and host fair competition shoots in July and August. Shooting disciplines offered are Air Rifle, Archery, Air Pistol, .22 Rifle and Shotgun. In the winter months we are able to practice Archery and Air Rile indoors and the summer months we practice all disciplines outside. All equipment to participate is provided but youth are welcome to bring their own to practice if they prefer. Equipment safety checks will happen at the beginning of practice.

Participant Requirements:

- Archery and Air Rifle is open to any youth in 3rd grade and above.
- 22 Rifle, Air Pistol and Shotgun: youth must be 12 years or older and have completed hunter safety to participate.
- Members must enroll in one or more of the following projects they plan to practice in via 4hOnline by April 1; Air Rifle, Air Pistol, Archery, .22 Rifle, Shotgun or Shooting Sports.
- If you plan to compete in a fair competition shoot youth must attend at least **two practices** to participate in Fair Shoots.
