Grant County 4-H Project Record Information



DO NOT INCLUDE THIS SHEET IN RECORD BOOK

The following guidelines should be followed in regard to 4-H Member Project Records for the Grant County 4-H Program. Form names can be found at the bottom of each record book page.

4-H MEMBER PROJECT RECORD SHEET

All 4-H members are required to complete one (1) copy of the Grant County 4-H Member Record Sheet or specified record sheet for each project they carry. (Form 7a)

4-H PROJECT FINANCIAL RECORD INFORMATION

4-H members grade 6 and under are <u>not required</u> to fill out a 4-H Project Financial Record for any project. 4-H members grade 7 and over, as of January 1 of the year enrolling, must complete a 4-H Project Financial Record as follows:

- 1. Form 7b <u>Grant County Financial Record</u> (yellow) is for all non-animal projects except for Clothing, Foods & Nutrition and Photography.
- 2. Form 7b <u>Animal Grant County Financial Record</u> (orange) is for all animal projects, including large and small animals. One form per species.
- Members enrolled in the following projects will use specific project sheets, which include financial reports: (required for <u>all</u> grades in these projects)
 Clothing purple
 Foods & Nutrition– gray
 Photography buff

CLOTHING PROJECTS

Clothing members in grades 3 and over are required to complete a Clothing Record Summary.

DAIRY

Dairy members 7th grade and over are required to complete a copy of the Lifetime Dairy record for <u>each animal</u> <u>they carry</u>. Members grades 3 to 6 may complete the Lifetime Dairy record, but it is not required.

FOODS & NUTRITION

Foods & Nutrition members in grades 3 and over are required to complete a Foods Record Summary.

PHOTOGRAPHY PROJECTS

Photography members in grades 3 and over are required to complete a Photography Record Summary.

OPTIONAL ANIMAL MANAGEMENT RECORD

Members can use the optional animal management record form to help track management practices such as health, breeding, labor involved, etc. This can be included in your project records.
