Grant County 4-H Family Project Day provides **5-Kindergarteners through 5th graders** with an opportunity to make items as they explore 4-H projects. Come to the Youth and Agriculture Center at the Grant County Fairgrounds on Saturday, February 14, 2026 to join in on the fun! You do NOT need to be in 4-H to attend. The Family Project Day is **FREE** of charge thanks to the support from our sponsors, participating 4-H clubs and the Grant County 4-H Leaders' Association.

At each session, participants will have an opportunity to make a project they can take home. There are 12 different project opportunities encompassing a variety of areas including: woodworking, recycling, arts and crafts, and more! 4-H Family Project Day will give participants the opportunity to learn new skills, work with others and have fun. Each pre-registered youth will receive a free grab bag including a take home project and a snack after the fourth session thanks to our sponsors and the 4-H Leaders' Association!

First rank being your top choice and twelfth being your last option. Make sure to answer the three questions on the registration form regarding your choices.** Return the registration form to the Grant County Extension Office by January 30. Registration will be limited to 160 entries or by January 30; which ever happens first. Projects fill up quickly.

Registration is required and projects are filled in the order of pre-registration date. If bad weather, please listen to WGLR 97.7 radio station and check the email your provided for updates.

# 4-H Family Project Day

**\*\*Open to 5-year-old-Kindergarten through 5th Grade.** Participants do NOT need to be in 4-H\*\*

1. **BEADED KEYCHAIN** (HAZEL GREEN CLEVER CLOVERS 4-H CLUB) Using beads, create a keychain to use with your keys, bookbag, or coat. Multiple options of sports, animals, and more will be available from beginner level on up. *(limit 20 per session)*



2. **BEADED WRISTLETS/KEYCHAINS** (PLUM VALLEY BOOSTERS 4-H CLUB) Customize your own design for a wristlet or keychain. Keep for yourself or give as a gift. *(limit 10 per session)*



3. **BUILD A BIRDHOUSE** (WINGS OVER WI) All supplies will be provided to assemble your very own wooden birdhouse. Youth can take home the assembled birdhouse and customize even more. *(limit 25 per session)*



4. **CATAPULT CANNON** (ACTIVE AMERICANS 4-H CLUB) Using recycled materials, we will make a catapult cannon and practice shooting different items to see how accurate we can be! *(limit 10 per session)*



5. **DECORATED TIN CAN PENCIL HOLDER** (JR. LEADERS) Upcycle a tin can and decorate it with a variety of materials to make a unique holder for pencils or other items. *(limit 12 per session)*



6. **MINI BARN QUILT** (BLOCKHOUSE BUILDERS 4-H CLUB) Come join the Blockhouse Builders 4-H Club to paint your own mini barn quilt. You will get to pick out one of five designs for a 1 foot by 1 foot wooden barn quilt you would like to paint. An email will be sent to participants to choose their design before the event. *(limit 12 per session)*



7. **PIPE CLEANER CHRISTMAS ORNAMENT** (BUSY BADGERS 4-H CLUB) Get ready for next year with this ornament project. There will be different options to choose from. *(limit 8 per session)*



8. **SOCK BUNNIES** (STITZER GO-GETTERS 4-H CLUB) No-sew sock bunnies for Spring! Select from a variety of color options for your bunny and decorate it with ribbon or bows. *(limit 10 per session)*



9. **SQUIGGLE BOTS** (DAIRYLAND DIAMONDS 4-H CLUB) Create your artistic robot! Make the electricity flow and watch art be created! *(limit 15 per session)*




10. **STAINED GLASS PICTURE** (TOWN & COUNTRY KIDS 4-H CLUB) Using an 8x10 frame with glass., draw or trace a picture on the glass. Color the picture in with colored Sharpies. Crinkle up aluminum foil and spread it out flat. The picture frame and foil all back together give it the stained glass effect. *(limit 15 per session)*



11. **WOOD SNOWMAN** (PLATTEVILLE WOODCHUCKS 4-H CLUB) Small wood snowman that will be assembled and decorated by participants. May only require use of wood glue. *(limit 12 per session)*



12. **WOODEN STEP STOOL** (MERRY MIXERS 4-H CLUB) Pre-cut wood pieces will be assembled into a step stool. Participants will decorate their 11"x11" step stool with the option of adding a stenciled painted design on the top or decorate it by woodburning. Stencils will be available, but you may bring your own. An email will be sent to participants before the event to choose from one of our designs, if they would like a pre-made stencil. *(limit 10 per session)*
